Intro: 1:1-9, Paul's confidence in them

I. Intro to book: Developing unity and wisdom in Messiah, 1 Cor 1:11; 7:1

1 Cor 1:11 I have been informed concerning you, 1-6 (Our witness in Our unity); 7:1, what you wrote (wisdom for our maturity), 7-16

Corinth Congregation planted 51-52 AD; this letter written around spring of 54 AD.. Paul wrote four letters to them: 1) the previous letter mentioned (1 Cor 5:9); 2) 1 Corinthians; 3) a severe letter (2 Cor 2:3–4; 4) 2 Corinthians. Only 1 & 2 Corinthians are extant.

 - 1. The Normal Marriage Condition: selfless duty, 7:1-6.

 - 1. Widows are free to remarry in the Lord, 39.

You're complete in Messiah: Your social condition is your spiritual opportunity not your personal fulfillment.

II. Questions about Liberty, 8-11: Love Limits Liberty

1 Cor 8-11 limiting our liberty as to: weaker believers (8), unbelievers (9), and the Lord (10). Rights (etsousia) is freedom of choice, 8:9 (liberty); 9:4 (right), 5, 6, 12, 18; 11:10 (authority).

A. When is Liberty abusive to Weaker Believers: liberty based on knowledge 1 Corinthians 8:1-13

- 1. When it is a substitute for love, 8:1-7
 - a. Then it isn't maturity in the Lord, 1
 - b. Then it isn't intimacy with the Lord, 2-3

Tanach values: 8:1-3 from 8:1-3 from Dt 6:5; Lev 19:18; Jer 9:23-24

c. Then it isn't ministry for the Lord, 4-7

Tanach values: 8:4-6 from Deut 6:4

2. When it is stumbles to the least, 8:8-11

Tanach values: 8:9 from Lev 19:14 (Deut 27:28), Isaiah 57:14-15; Eze 18:30; 44:12; Ps 119:165

3. When it is a sin against the Lord, 8:12-13 We learn to be prioritizing people above pleasure, possessions and power.

Tanach values: 8:11-12 from Isa 53:5-6

Do not discourage weaker believers but edify the least! The result of learning is to be love, so our "liberties" will minister life. B. The Sacrifice of My Rights for Successful Service: liberty based on rights

1 Corinthians 9:1-27

- In 9:1-14: Paul notes his right to receive compensation for his service in Messiah:
 - 1) as to his position, 9:1-2
 - 2) as to what's reasonable, 9:3-4
 - 3) as to what's fair, 9:5-6
 - 4) as to the Torah, 9:7-11
 - 5) as to the Temple service, 9:12-13
 - 6) as to the Messiah's teaching, 9:14

So, don't let your rights become a hindrance to the Good News, 9:12.

Tanach values 9:7 is from Pro 27:18; Deu 20:6; 9:8-9 is from Deu 25:4; 9:13 in Lev 6:16, 26; 7:6, 31-38

- 1. Self-supported: the sacrifice of preaching fees to win souls, 9:15-18
 - a. His Responsibility, 9:15-16.
 - b. His Reward, 9:17-18.

Tanach value: 9:16 from Jer 20:8-9 & Eze 33:2-11; 9:17 from Ps 110:3; 9:18 from Isa 40:10; 62:11

- 2. Self-denial: the sacrifice of personal freedom to win souls, 9:19-23
 - a. My volition in self-denial for winning people, 9:19
 - b. My varieties of self-denial in winning people, 9:20-22, by the syntax it is two groups.
 - 1) To the Jews, 20-21:
 - a) To the Torah abiding Jews, 20: we may live more stringently for the Good News
 - b) To the Torah-less Jews, 21: we may live less stringently for the Good News
 - 2) To the weak, 22 (Gentiles weak in conscience defiled, 8:7; stumbled, 8:9; ruined, 8:11)
 - c. My investment thru self-denial in winning people, 23.

Tanach values: 9:19 in Ex 20:14-15; 1 Sam 21:4-5; Jer 30:9. 9:23 from Psalm 19:10; 119:103

- 3. Self-control: the sacrifice of present fulfillment, 9:24-27
- Be committed to successful service in the Good News, 9:24.
- Use self-control in everything for the Good News, and not for perishable things, 9:25.
- So have certain aim and focus for the Good News; don't swing wildly, 9:26.
- Use what is under your stewardship for God's purpose in the Good News, 9:27.
- We control ourselves to accomplish the will of God in the Good News.

Tanach values: 9:25 from Gen 43:31.

Surrender your personal rights now to enjoy eternal rewards forever! Never distract from the Good News but evangelize the lost.

- C. The Mature Exalt the Lord of Liberty: liberty based on position 1 Corinthians 10:1-11:1
 - 1. The Malfunction of exalting God, 10:1-10: Foolishness before the Lord a. Israel were privileged people, 10:1-4
 - 1) Their privileged protection: Identified with Moses, 10:1-2
 - 2) Their privileged provision: Satisfied with Messiah, 10:3-4.

Tanach values: **10:1-2** from Ex 13:21-22; 14:29-31. <u>**10:3-4**</u> from Ex 16:4; Ps 78:24-25; Ex 17:7-8, Num 20:10-12

b. Israel was presumptuous examples, 10:5-10

Tanach values: **10:7** from Ex 32:6; 10:8 from Num 25; **10:9** from Num 21; **10:10** from Num 16:11, 32-33, 35, 41, 49

The unprivileged faithful please the Lord; the privileged faithless displease the Lord.

- 2. The exhortation for exalting God, 10:11-14: Followers of the Lord a. Learn to be wise and beware, 10:11-12
 - b. Learn to endure and evade, 10:13-14

The mature are implementing the truth; the immature are irresponsible in trials.

- 3. The application for exalting God, 10:15-22: Our Fellowship with the Lord
 - a. Messianic Fellowship is participation in His sacrifice, 16-17:
 - b. Altar Fellowship is participation in principle, 18:
 - c. Pagan Fellowship is participation with demons, 19-20
 - d. Decided Fellowship is participation or provocation, 21-22:

Application 1. Glorify God regarding food, 10:23-11:1: Our Freedom in the Lord

- a. Dedication to other's prosperity, 10:23-24: Be sure you live to seek profit others
- b. Recognition of our liberty, 10:25-27: Be sure not to distract from what edifies
- c. Prioritization of believer's frailty, 10:28-30: Sacrifice of personal freedom
- d. Exhortation for His glory, 10:31-11:1: Be sure to live for Yeshua with a concern for all

Tanach values: 10:26 from Dt 10:14; Ps 24:1

The mature major in the majors; immature major in the minors: Do not dishonor His name but exalt the Lord

Application 2. Glorify God regarding marriage: Functional Subordination in a Faithful Society 1 Corinthians 11:2-16

Liberty abused: in the witness in culture (11:2-16), in worship thru ceremony (11:17-34).

a. Functional subordination as a universal principle of Headship, 11:2-3

1) The issues of headship: Father-Son-husband-wife; in Scripture, society is ordered in 5 ways: in society, work, assembly, marriage, and family.

2) Functional subordination: Jn 5:18ff; Jn 10:30.

- b. Functional subordination as a religious custom of that community, 11:4-7
 - 1) The dishonor of the head by men, 11:4:

- c. Functional subordination as a symbolic custom from creation, 11:8-12
 - 1) The creation glory for men & women, 11:7
 - 2) It does symbolizes creation calling, 11:8-10
 - 3) It doesn't symbolize gender superiority, 11:11-12

- d. Functional subordination as a distinction custom in Corinth, 11:13-15
 - 1) Principle of personal responsibility, 11:13

e. Functional insubordination as a contentious custom of the Corinthians, 11:16.

The spiritual content are not culturally contentious!

Application 3. Glorify God regarding ceremonies: The Factions of the Faith 1 Corinthians 11:17-34

a. Factions exist despite Messiah's death, 11:17-19.

b. Factions evidenced by Messiah's death, 11:20-22

His love will limit your liberty or your liberty will limit His love!

III. Questions about Gifts, 1 Cor 12:1-14:40

A. The Giver of the gifts, 12:1-31 Introduction: spiritual chaos

- 1. The gifts are directed by the Giver, 12:1-11: The sovereignty of the Lord manifested
 - a. Directed to exalt His worth, 12:1-3.
 - b. Directed to edify His work, 12:4-7.
 - c. Directed to express His will, 12:8-11.

Tanach values: 12:1-3 from Ex 31:1-7; 35:30-31, 34-35; 36:1-2; Deut 13:1-11; 1 Kings 7:14

- 2. The gifts are determined by the Giver, 12:12-27: The unity in the Lord ministered
 - a. Determined to differ from each other, 12:12-19.
 - b. Determined to depend on each other, 12:20-22.
 - c. Determined to defer to each other, 12:23-27.

Tanach values: 12:12-27 from 2 Sam 7:8; 1 Kings 3:9, 12, 28; Dan 1:17; 2:21

- 3. The gifts are designated by the Giver, 12:28-31a: The authority from the Lord mandated
 - a. Designated by position, 12:28.
 - b. Designated by possession, 12:29-30.
 - c. Designated by priority, 12:31a.

Tanach values: 12:28-31 from Num 16:1-5, 9-10

Unless you're right with the Giver, you're wrong with the gift!

- B. The greater than the gifts, 13:1-13
 - 1. Love is profitable; gifts are useless without love, 13:1-3
 - a. Gift of eloquence: communicating truth is useless without love, 1
 - b. Gift of :prophecy: comprehending truth is useless without love, 2a
 - c. Gift of faith: conquering truth is useless without love, 2b
 - d. Gift of giving: consecrating truth is useless without love, 3

 - 2) The clarity of love and the obscurity of gifts, 12

4. Love is preeminent, gifts are irrelevant without love, 13:13

Love is to be pursued, not gifts, as the Lord is be sought, not His blessings. Your lack of growth comes not from a lack of gifts, but a lack of love. Seeking love is seeking God; seeking gifts; is seeking self.

- 2. The congregation's edifying practice of gifts: Is it communicating to all? 14:6-19
 - a. All congregational preaching is to be edifying, 14:6-12
 - b. All congregational praying is to be edifying, 14:13-17
 - c. All congregational participation is to be edifying, 14:18-19

Tanach values: 14:8 from Num 10:9; Neh 4:18-21; 14:10-11 from Gen 11:7; 14:13-17 from 1 Sam 1:10-15

- 3. The Congregation's edifying purpose in gifts: Is it convincing thru all? 14:20-26
 - a. Languages misused by all would bring confusion, 14:20-23
 - b. Love ministered by all would bring conviction, 14:24-26

Thus, in all things (26), love:

- ☆ determines growth within you,
- ☆ disseminates grace between you, and
- ☆ discloses God among you.

Guidance Part 2: Congregational Love is Not Chaotic, but Controlled by Grace, 1 Corinthians 14:27-40

- 1. Congregational love has regulations, 14:27-33
 - a. There is regulation for languages, 14:27-28
 - b. There is regulation for learning, 14:29-33

Tanach values: 14:27-33 from Isa 54:11; Judges 6:24; Isa 9:6

- 2. Congregational love has restrictions, 14:34-38
 - a. Restriction upon the ladies, 14:34-35
 - b. Restriction upon the leaders, 14:36-38

Tanach values: **14:34-35** from Gen 3:16; Num 30:6-8; **14:36-38** from Deut 13:1-5, Zep 3:4; Jer 14:14; 23:16; Ezek 13:3, 17

- 3. Congregational love has reasonableness, 14:39-40
 - a. Love is reasonable in its commands, 14:39
 - b. Love is reasonable in its conduct, 14:40

Tanach values: **14:39-40** from 1 Ki 7:37, Ps 110:4, Job 38:12.

When God is honored thru love there is harmony, not havoc.

Resurrection Matters: 1 Corinthians 15:1-58

b. End of the Mediatorial reign: The first fruits resurrection guarantees that the Father is glorified, 15:24-28.

4. A motivational matter, 15:29-34

5. The material matter, 15:35-41 (How & What)

6. The scriptural matter, 15:42-49

Tanach values 15:42-49 from Gen 2:7; Hosea 6:7

- 7. The transformational matter, 15:50-58: Yom Teruah, Day of Trumpets a. What is the Last Trumpet, 15:50-53?
 - b. What is removed, 15:54-58?

Tanach values 15:50-53 from Lev 23:24; Zec 9:14; Isa 25:8; 15:54-58 from Isa 53:12; Ezek 18:4

The resurrection of Messiah's body guarantees the resurrection of Messiah's Body
